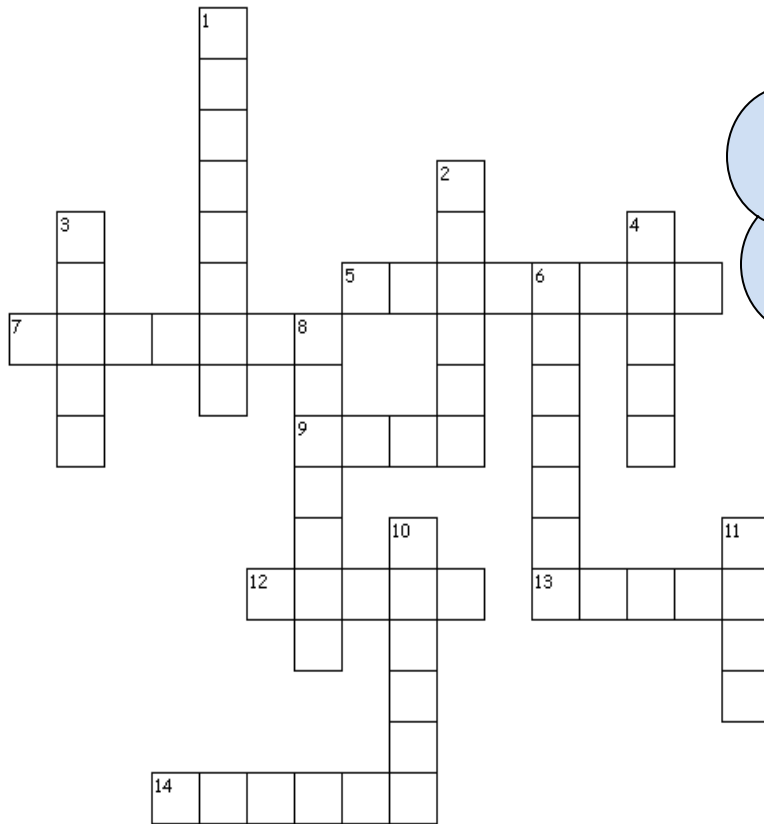


# Biology Fun Crossword Puzzle
